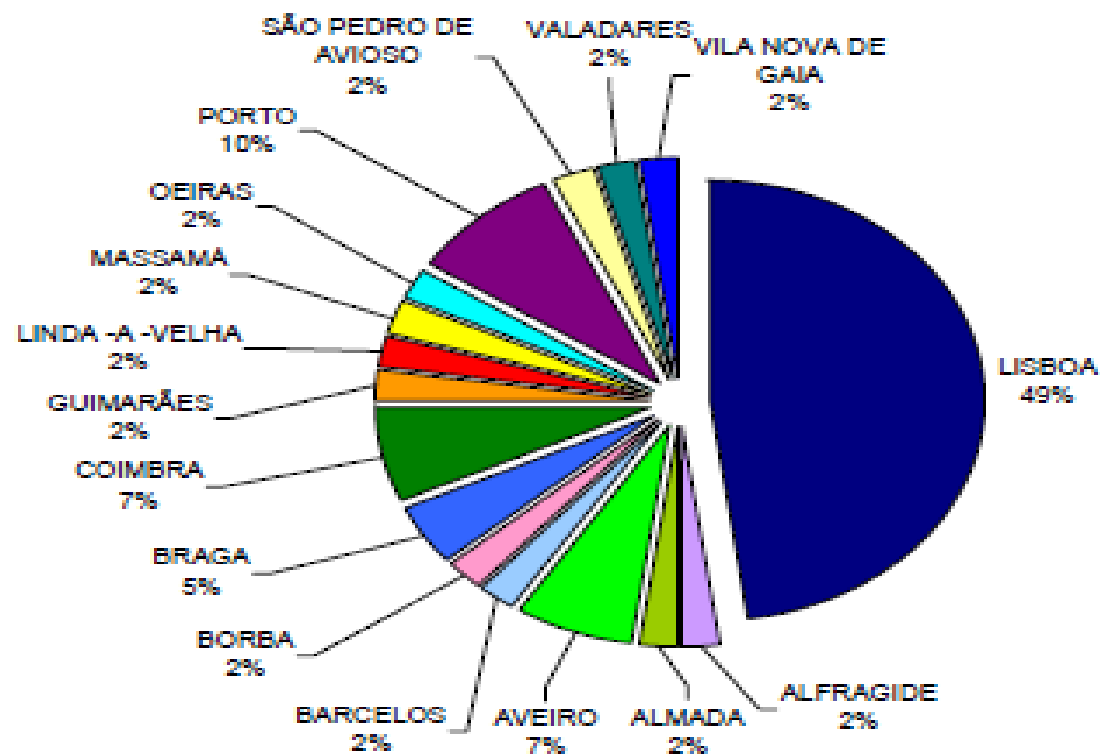

CONTEXT AND PERSPECTIVES *(Survey made on 2007)*

- Information Society context less favourable
- Creation of a critical mass in favour of e-learning
- Market answers for e-learning not enough to needs
- Low technological literacy of the population and the high cost of Internet access
- Greater organizations have projects on e-learning (Universities, High Schools, Companies)
- 89% of Organisations have not implemented e-learning solutions
- Private and Public Companies are aware on e-learning solutions

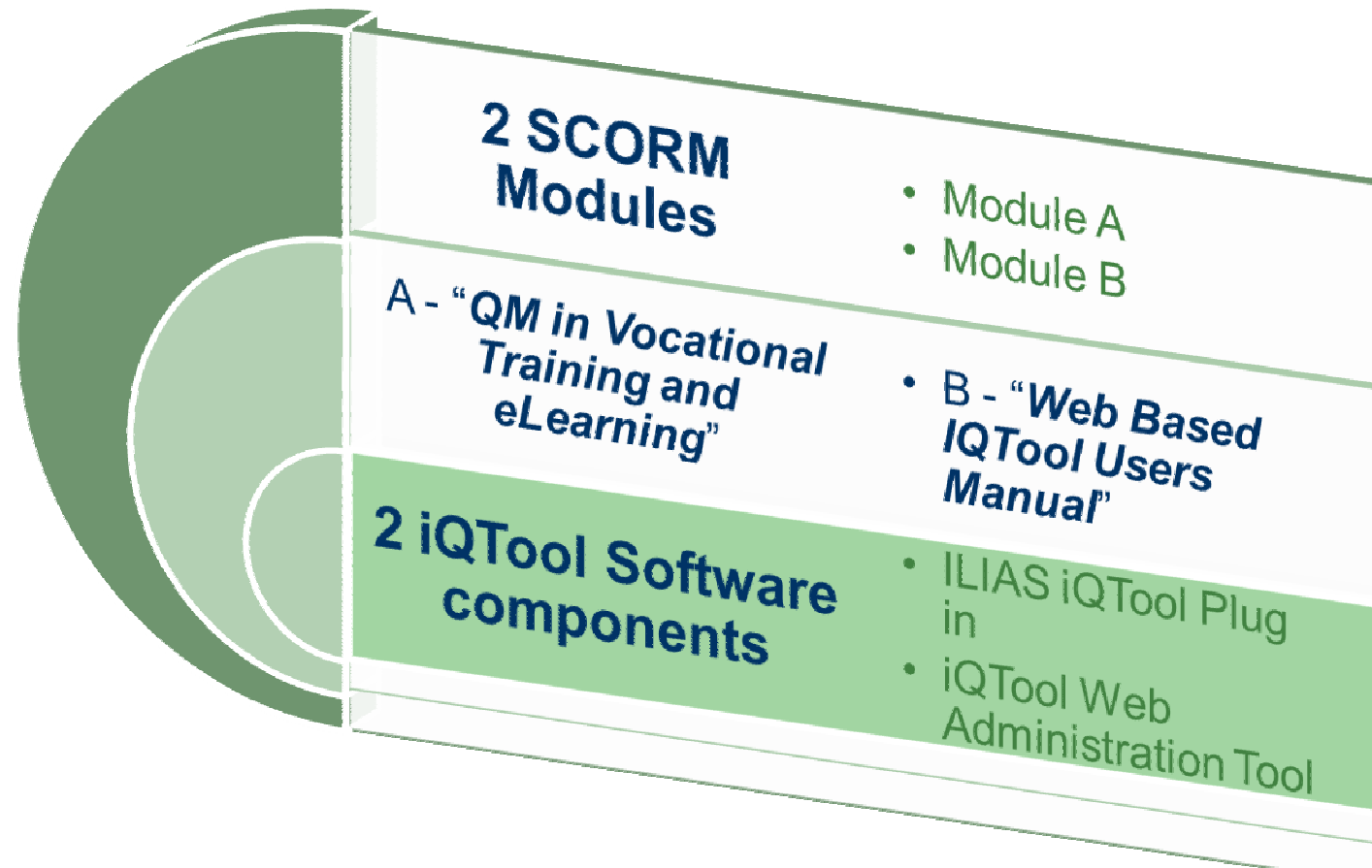
